

THE MYSTERY OF THE GODHEAD

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The mystery of the Deity is hidden from some.

- **Luke 10:21-22**, *"In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight. (22) All things are delivered to me of my Father: and no man knoweth who the Son is, but the Father; and who the Father is, but the Son, and he to whom the Son will reveal him."*
- **Matthew 11:25-27**, *At that time Jesus answered and said, "I thank You, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that You have hidden these things from the wise and prudent and have revealed them to babes. ²⁶Even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight. ²⁷All things have been delivered to Me by My Father, and no one knows the Son except the Father. Nor does anyone know the Father except the Son, and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him.*

Who raised Jesus from the dead?

- **John 10:17**, *Therefore doth my Father love me, because I lay down my life, that I might take it again. ¹⁸No man taketh it from me, but I lay it down of myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again.*
- **John 2:19**, *Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.*
- Check the following the following statements and see if they are in your Bible: God the Son; Trinity; Three Persons; God the Father; God the Son; and God the Holy Ghost; Three separate and Distinct Persons.
- God said in **Isaiah 43:10**, *"Ye are my witnesses, saith the Lord, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me."*

Is there one God, two gods, or many gods?

- **St. John 1:1-14**, *In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (2) The same was in the beginning with God. (3) All things were made by him, and without him was not any thing made that was made. (4) In him was life, and the life was the light of men. (5) And the light shineth in darkness: and the darkness comprehended it not...(10) He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. (11) He came unto his own and his own received him not. (12) But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: (13) Which was*

born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor the will of man, but of God. (14) And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us. (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father.) full of grace and truth.

Was Jesus God in the form of man?

- **1 Timothy 3:16**, *And without controversy, great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.*

Could Jesus have been on earth and in heaven at the same time?

- **John 3:13**, *And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven.*
- **Colossians 1:16-17**, *For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in the earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him. (17) And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.*

Does the Bible say there is but one Lord?

- **Isaiah 45:18**, *For thus saith the Lord that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited; I am the Lord; and there is none else.*
- **1 John 5:7**, *For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost; and these three are one.* This is the only verse in the entire Bible that speaks openly about three, yet in conclusion, it says they are one.
- **Zechariah 14:9**, *And the Lord shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one Lord, and his name one.*
- **Malachi 2:10**, *Have we not all one father? Hath not one God created us?*
- **Matthew 23:9**, *And call no man father upon the earth; for one is your Father, which is in heaven.*
- **Mark 12:29**, *And Jesus answered him, the first of all the commandments is, Hear O Israel; the Lord our God is one Lord.*
- **John 10:30**, *I and my Father are one.*
- **Romans 3:30**, *Seeing it is one God, which shall justify the circumcision by faith, and the uncircumcision through faith.*
- **1 Corinthians 8:4**, *...and there is none other God but one.*
- **Galatians 3:20**, *Now a mediator is not a mediator of one, but God is one.*
- **Ephesians 4:5-6**, *One Lord, one faith, one baptism, (6) One God and father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.*
- **1 Timothy 2:5**, *For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.*
- **James 2:19**, *Thou believest that there is one God: thou doest well: the devils also believe, and tremble.*

The mystery of the Godhead can be understood.

- **Romans 1:20**, *For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse;*
- **Colossians 2:9**, *For in him dwelleth all the fullness of the Godhead bodily.*

The Prophet, Isaiah, said that Jesus was the Father.

- **Isaiah 9:6**, *For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall*
- *be upon his shoulder and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.*

How many gods does God know? How many gods should we know?

- **Isaiah 43:10-11**, *Ye are my witnesses, saith the Lord, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me. (11) I, even I, am the Lord: and beside me there is no savior.*
- **Isaiah 44:8**, *Fear ye not, neither be afraid: have not I told thee from that time, and have declared it? ye are even my witnesses. Is there a God beside me? yea, there is no God: I know not any.*
- **Isaiah 45:21-23**, *Tell ye, and bring them near: yea, let them take counsel together: who hath declared this from ancient time? who hath told it from that time? have not I the Lord? and there is no God else beside me: a just God and a Savior: there is none beside me. (22) Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else. (23) I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.*
- **Romans 14:11**, *"For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.*
- **Philippians 2:11-12**, *That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth: (11) and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.*

There is one person in the Godhead.

- **Job 13:8**, *Will ye accept his person? will ye contend for God?*
- **Hebrews 1:3**, *Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, and when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;*
- **2 Corinthians 4:4**, *In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.*
- **Colossians 1:19**, *For it pleased the Father that in him should all the fulness dwell.*

- **Colossians 2:9**, *For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.*

Where was God the Father while Jesus was on earth?

- **2 Corinthians 5:19**, *To wit, that God was in Christ reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the work of reconciliation.*
- **John 14:10**, *Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the works that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.*

When God said, *Let us make man in our image*, was He speaking to another person in the Godhead?

- **Malachi 2:10**, *Have we not all one father? hath not one God created us?*

Who is the first and the last and the Almighty?

- **Isaiah 44:6**, *Thus saith the Lord the King of Israel, and his redeemer the Lord of hosts; I am the first, and the last; and beside me there is no God.*
- **Revelation 1:8**, *Jesus said, I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, which is, and which was, and which is to come, the Almighty.*
- **Revelation 22:13**, *Jesus said, I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end, the first and the last.*

Who should we worship and who should we serve?

- **Matthew 4:10**, *(Jesus talking to Satan), Then saith Jesus, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.*
- **Exodus 34:14**, *For thou shall worship no other god: for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God*
- **Matthew 2:2** *...for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.*
- **Hebrews 1:6**, *...and again when he bringeth in the firstbegotten into the world, he saith, And let all the angels of God worship him.*
- **Matthew 7:24**, *No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one and love thee other: or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other, ye cannot serve God and mammon.*
- **Exodus 20:3**, *Thou shalt have no other gods before me.*

Does the Bible say that Christ is the Lord?

- **Luke 2:11**, *For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord.*

Does the Bible say that the Lord is God?

- **1 Kings 18:39**, *And when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces: and they said, The Lord, he is the God; The Lord, he is the God.*
- **Acts 2:39**, *For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call.*
- **Revelation 19:1**, *And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honor, and power, unto the Lord our God.*

Who can forgive sin?

- **Isaiah 43:25**, *I, even I, am he that blotteth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins.*
- **Mark 2:5-7** Jesus said, *...Son, thy sins be forgiven thee... (7) Why doth this man thus speak blasphemies? who can forgive sins but God only?*

Who shed his blood for the church?

- **Acts 20:28**, *Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.*

What about Elohim; does this mean more than one god?

- "Elohim" is identified by Moses as being *One Lord* in **Deuteronomy 6:4**. Moses commanded the Hebrews to teach the fact that *The Lord our God is One Lord* as a matter of priority above all other facts of life. Every Jewish child had this monotheistic concept imposed upon his or her thinking to the extent that absolutely no other person but God the Father was ever allowed to be worshipped.

JESUS CHRIST IS NOT A CLONE OF GOD THE FATHER. HE IS NOT A DUPLICATE DEITY. HE IS NOT JEHOVAH, JR, HE IS THE ALMIGHTY GOD!

- **Ephesians 4:6**, *One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all.*
- **John 8:19**, *If ye believe not that I AM HE, ye shall die in your sins.*

There are many more Scriptures proving only one God!

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
